

2010 Lindale Rodeo Queen Contestant Regulations

1. Contestant must be 16 years of age on or before the first day of competition and no older than 24 years of age on or before the first day of competition.
2. Contestant cannot have ever been married or have had a child.
3. Contestant will be required to sell 50 Rodeo Tickets for Thursday's performance to qualify and 150 Raffle Tickets. Contestants will be responsible for tickets assigned to them.
4. Contestant will be responsible for her own horse and transportation. A copy of current coggins is required at the first practice.
5. In the case of a tie, the contestant with the highest interview score will be the winner.
6. At the discretion of the Queen Director, score sheets may be distributed after the contest.
7. Judges decision is final and may not be appealed or contested. Contact between any judge and contestant, or contestant's parents, must be initiated by the judge and not initiated by the contestant.
8. If at any time during the competition, a judge or member of the board feels that the contestant and/or her horse is unsafe they can and will be removed from the competition.
9. Any decision/interpretation made by the Board of Directors of the Rodeo Association in regard to this pageant (rules, etc.) is final and may not be appealed or contested.
10. Any violation of these rules and regulations satisfied in this document may result in disqualification of contestant.
11. Rodeo Ticket Sales-extra points will be awarded as follows for tickets sales above the required 50.
75 = 5 points
100 = 10 points

12. Judging will be based on:

Horsemanship	40%
Interview & Personality	40%
Ticket Sales	20%

13. The winner of the 2010 Miss Lindale Rodeo Competition will be required to compete in the Miss UPRA Queen's Contest. Failure to be willing and/or able to compete in the Miss UPRA Queen's Contest will result in the immediate removal of her title and awards (scholarship, crown, saddle & buckle). The first runner-up will then be awarded the title and awards pending ability to meet obligations of the title. If the 1st runner-up is unable to meet obligations the title and awards will go to 2nd Runner-up, pending meeting all obligations of the title.
14. The entry deadline for the 2010 Miss Lindale Rodeo Queen Competition is March 22, 2010..
